A nineteenth century timber house on a reduced site built in 1896. It is historically significant as a representative embodiment of rural family life in late nineteenth century Ringwood. It is architecturally significant as representative an unpretentious Victorian domestic manner, locally.

Physical Description 1

A double-fronted nineteenth century timber house, with a corrugated steel roof. It consists of two parallel gables facing Warrandyte Road. The (former) front has a concave skillion verandah across, with a cast-iron lace valence and brickwork between bevelled Doric timber posts. Gables have mock shingles and turned finials. Chimneys are red brick with corbelled tops. There are two double-hung window pairs; top sashes are six-paned, the left are narrower, facing the road. Another skillion verandah is at the left side, (the former rear), with another window pair also. There are several remnant pines.

Intactness

The left chimney looks recent. Verandahs may have been renovated. The picket fence is recent and other works may also be.
