A simple timber California Bungalow, unusually symmetrical, built in the 1920s with appropriate paint colours and contextual trees. It is historically significant as a representative embodiment of rural town family life in 1920s Ringwood. It is architecturally significant as a characteristic unpretentious example of this domestic style, unusual for its symmetry.

Physical Description 1

A simple double-fronted symmetrical timber Californian Bungalow, with a gable-roof facing, in corrugated steel. There are two roughcast chimneys with pots. The upper gable is timbered roughcast, jettied on joists across the front, and beneath the roof extends the verandah. This has two shallow bow-windows beneath, and there is another at the left side. The timber posts have fretwork haunch brackets. The entrance is flanked by two cypresses. Paint colours are appropriate.
