The Bacchus Marsh and Melton Memorial Hospital, on Grant Street, was erected in 1954. It is dedicated to thirty-one soldiers who fell in the Second World War. Also on the grounds is a Lone Pine planting with a plaque listing the names of those who served in the First World War.
