The Darley Park Monuments comprise of cairns dedicated to the Second World War and the Vietnam War. The first plaque reads, "*39th Infantry Battalion Raised at Darley Camp October 1941. Being the first troops to cross the Kokoda Track, they were withdrawn from action January 1943 with only 7 officers and 25 other ranks remaining. Lest We Forget. Shire Bacchus Marsh.*"

The second plaque reads, "This plaque is dedicated to the young service personnel who died and suffered during the Vietnam Conflict 1962-1973."
