## **Veterans Description for Public**

The Walter John Spiers Memorial, located in the sports ground, comprises of small stone monument erected in 1992. The plaque records that Bamawm local, Spiers, was killed in action at Mount Tambu, New Guinea on July 16th 1943. He was buried in the Lae War Cemetery.
