The Colac Park Memorial comprises of a small rock monument with a plaque. The plaque is inscribed with "To the Last Man and Last Shilling", an expression of the early Anzac tradition. The monument records the fact that the expression originated in a speech delivered in Colac by Andrew Fisher, leader of the Federal Opposition, on

July 1st 1914.
