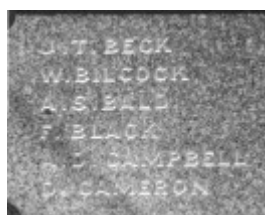

The Croydon War Memorial, comprising of a stone obelisk was unveiled on October 27th 1919. The memorial lists the names of 76 fallen and returned servicemen from the First World War, Second World War, Korea and Vietnam.
