

#### **Veterans Description for Public**

The Dimboola Memorial Secondary College stands in the former Soldier's Memorial Hall on Ellerman and Muller Streets. The building was established on December 2nd 1924 in memory of the First World War. The entrance gates to the College are dedicated to the Second World War and inside the building there are honour rolls listing the names of 31 fallen and returned soldiers from the Second World War and Korea.
