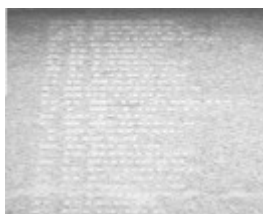

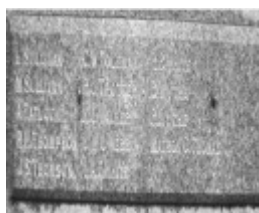

The Hamilton War Memorial, located in the Melville Oval, was unveiled April 25th 1926. The monument is a grand statue featuring the figure of peace, raised on four pillars. The memorial lists the names of 160 soldiers who died fighting in the First World War, Second World War, Korea, Malaya, the Indonesian Confrontation and Vietnam.
