The foundation stone for the St. Andrews Church Peace Memorial Hall was laid on March 16th 1957 by Dr. S.C. FitzPatrick. It is dedicated to those who served and those who died serving in the First and Second World

Wars. The inscription reads: "*These turned from the quiet of this parish that their children might worship here in freedom and peace.*"
