The Hawthorn War Memorial, in St. James Park on Burwood Road, was erected in March 1929. The memorial is a coloured brick cenotaph, dedicated to the First World War, with inscriptions added for the Second World War, Korea, Malaya, Borneo and Vietnam wars.
