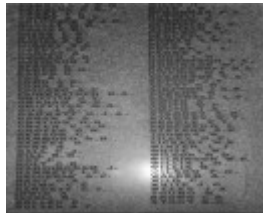

The Ivanhoe War Memorial, on Studley and Upper Heidelberg Roads, comprises of a tablet framed by two classical pillars and a pediment. The tablet lists the names of those who served (including 47 fallen soldiers) in the First World War and the Second World War. In 1995, on the 50th Anniversary of the end of the Second World War, a low pebble wall was erected around the monument. The wall features plaques dedicated to the fallen of the Second World War and those who served Australia in Korea, Malaya, Borneo and Vietnam.
