The Jindivick War Memorial is located in a garden at the junction of Drouin Road and Jackson's Track. The memorial comprises of a coloured stone cairn and is dedicated to four residents who fell in the Second World War. Against each name is the date and the place of battle where they died:

W.L. Wembridge, Bardia 5.1.41

T.N. MacFarlane, El Alamein 31.10.42

G.A. Pincott, Salamaua 27.5.43

E.H. Peel, Lost at Sea 1.7.42
