The Kallista War Memorial, on Tom Roberts Road and Church Street, comprises of two boulders leant against one another. The monument was unveiled on the 50th Anniversary of the end of the Second World War, August 19th 1995. The memorial is dedicated to 87 fallen and returned Kallista residents who served in the Boer War,

First World War, Second World War and Vietnam.
