The Lake Bolac Memorial Hall was erected in 1922, on the site between the blacksmith shop and the hotel. In 1959, a Memorial Foyer was added to the building to commemorate the Second World War. On the exterior of the building is a black marble tablet listing the names of those residents who served and those who did not return from the First World War, Second World War and Vietnam.
