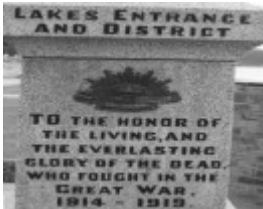

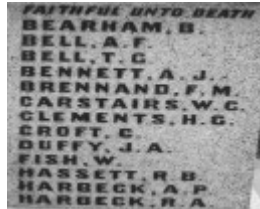

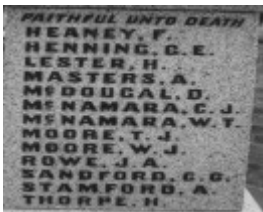

The Lakes Entrance War Memorial, on Marine Parade, comprises of a granite obelisk resting between two flagstaffs on a paved square. The obelisk was originally erected to commemorate the First World War but was rededicated to include the names of those who served in the Second World War. A plaque was also added to include later wars in Korea, Malaya, Borneo, Vietnam and the Gulf War.
