The Merino Soldiers Settlement Memorial commemorates the establishment of the Glenorchy Estate by 38 servicemen who returned from the First World War. The plaque was erected in 2004 by the Glenorchy Progress Association with funds from the Federal Government's "Saluting Their Service Program."
