The Mount Evelyn Memorial Pre-School, on Birmingham Road, was built in 1945 as a memorial to all those who served during the Second World War. The inscription reads, "*This Pre-School Centre stands as a living memorial to all who served in the Second World War 1939-1945, by working for the happiness and well-being of its children*"

Mount Evelyn seeks to Honour worthily their sacrifice. In 1956, this hall was re-built through the labour and perseverance of committee mothers and friends working under the inspiration and leadership of Mrs. O.J. Adams (President since its inauguration in 1945)."
