Veterans Description for Public

The Murchison War Memorial, on Stephenson Street, is an ornamental structure featuring a cupola with a small orb that rests on four red granite columns on a granite pedestal. The cupola features the emblem of the Australian Commonwealth Military Forces, while the pedestal lists the names of those locals who served in the First World War and the Second World War. The main inscription reads, "*We lie dead in many lands, that you may live here in peace.*"

This place/object may be included in the Victorian Heritage Register pursuant to the Heritage Act 2017. Check the Victorian Heritage Database, selecting 'Heritage Victoria' as the place source.
