The Nar Nar Goon War Memorial is located on Seven Mile Road and Carney Street. Erected on 11th November 1999, the memorial is dedicated to the district men and women who served in the First World War, Second World War, Korea and Vietnam. The memorial consists of a wide grey obelisk encircled by a tiered wall, with plaques featuring the names of those who served.
