The Noble Park Memorial Swimming Pool is dedicated to the services and sacrifices of men and women who served Australia in the armed forces during the Second World War. The pool was opened on Anzac Day 1963 with a bronze plaque that reads, "*The deeds and services of these men and women provided the inspiration to the Springvale - Noble Park Memorial Swimming Pool Association to help establish this swimming pool as a perpetual expression of gratitude of the citizens of the City of Springvale.*"
