## **Veterans Description for Public**

The Noble Park Nurses Memorialis located inside the Commemorative Park at the junction of Mons Parade and Heatherton Road. The memorial is a rough granite stone with a plaque dedicated to 100 years of service given by Australian Nurses in all wars, from the Boer War through the two world wars and conflicts until 2000. The

monument was officially opened by Mrs Wilma Young nee Oram (AM, former P.O.W. of the Japanese) on Remembrance Day 1999.
