The Norlane R.S.L. War Memorial, at 29 Rose Avenue, comprises of a flagstaff with a rough stone base. The stone base is inscribed with "Lest We Forget" and originally belonged to the Memorial Infant Welfare Centre. On Anzac Day 1991, the stone was moved to the R.S.L. grounds and unveiled with the flagstaff by Mayor Joan

Rowe.
