#### **Veterans Description for Public**

The Rainbow War Memorial, on Federal Street, is a statuary monument of a digger staring straight ahead with his rifle upside down in the symbolic funereal position. The pedestal of the statue lists the names of those locals who served in the First and Second World War, 60 of whom never returned.
