The Rosebud War Memorial was erected by the Sailors, Soldiers and Airmen's Fathers Association, in memory of men and women who paid the supreme sacrifice in times of war. The memorial comprises of a wall inscribed with the dates of the world wars and a plaque for conflicts in Korea, Malaya and Vietnam. On the central panel of

the war is a silver cross and at each end of the wall rests a flower bed.
