The Shelford War Memorial, on Shelford Road, was unveiled on April 16th 1999. The memorial comprises of a large boulder and plaque dedicated to three fallen Second World War servicemen. The inscription reads, "*Pass not this stone in sorrow but in pride and may you live nobly as they died*."
