The Stawell War Memorial (in front of the WWI Memorial Statue) was constructed in the late 20th century and commemorates those who fought and died in the Second World War, Malayan, Korean, Borneo and Vietnam Wars. It is constructed of granite in the form of a coffin and is adorned with a spherical polished granite sculpture depicting planet Earth.
