The Swanpool War Memorial, on the Midlands Highway near the Memorial Hall, is dedicated to the First World War and Second World War. The memorial comprises of a marble digger blowing a bugle and 63 names of the fallen and returned soldiers are listed on the pedestal. It originally stood on the intersection of the Midlands Highway and Tatong Road but was moved to the Memorial Hall due to road works.
