The Tatura War Memorial Obelisk stands in the Robert Mactier V.C. Memorial Garden on Hogan Street. The obelisk commemorates those who served in the First World War, Second World War, Vietnam and the Victoria Cross Winner Private Robert Mactier. Mactier's heroic actions in the First World War allowed his battalion to capture the village of Mont St. Quentin.
