In the grounds of the former Wallacedale North is a memorial tree plaque dedicated to Australia's famous Aviation Pioneer Bert Hinkler. Hinkler served in the First World War as an observer-gunner with the Royal Naval

Air Service but it was his 1933 flight from England to Australia that proved fatal, crashing over Italy on 7th January.
