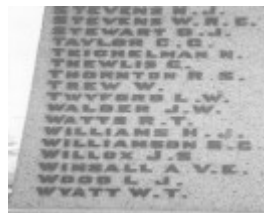

The Warracknabeal WWI Memorial Statue, on Scott Street, resembles a marble digger standing in the symbolic funereal position with his rifle upside down. The pedestal lists 93 district servicemen of the Borung Shire who made the supreme sacrifice in the First World War.
