The Warracknabeal WWI Memorial Gates are located at the entrance to the Anzac Park on Scott and Arnold Streets. The gates were erected by the women of Borung Shire in memory of the men who never returned from the First World War. The gates comprise of four large, ornate stone gate posts inscribed with the names of the fallen and cast-iron gates that feature the rising sun motifs.
