## **Physical Description 1**

#### DESCRIPTION

A triple-fronted, hip-roofed timber Edwardian house. Right and left side rear bays project as gables, with the verandah returning around the angle, under the hip. Chimneys have deep, brick mouldings and strip decoration, with terracotta pots. Upper gables jetty on decorative ogee brackets, clad with mock shingles, with turned finials, over a skillion windowhood on piecrust fretwork brackets, with latticework. The verandah valence is a palisade, with diagonal latticework over a moulded rail, with Roccco brackets an square Doric timber posts. The fourpanelled entrancedoor has side and fanlights. There is an embossed copper nameplace. (Obscured).
