Physical Description 1

One of a pair of semi-detached Victorian villas with generous front setbacks. A shared slated hip roof with no party wall between the two and two-storey return verandahs with convex roof, fluted cast-iron columns and cast-iron lace, and original front door.

The 1901 MMBW map shows only front verandahs to the pair (a more common solution), unknown when the reproduction returns were added to the side elevations (of both houses).
