Physical Description 1

Londesborough Terrace is a two-storey rendered Victorian terrace comprising four houses. It has two-storey verandahs with cast-iron lace, original front doors, rendered chimneys with mouldings at top, balusters to the parapet (and name of the terrace). All retain original ground-floor verandah tiles and 4-panelled front doors (some with flashed-glass sidelights). It is good condition and very intact to the main elevations.
