The Australian Hellenic memorial, opened in September 2011, honours the Australian and Hellenic men and women who have fought and died in war and peacekeeping. The monument also represents the 841 Australian servicemen who were killed in Greece and Crete during the Second World War and captures the values dear to both nations: democracy, liberty and peace.
