This is a fine specimen of Monterey Pine (*Pinus radiata*) located at the residence built in 1889 by Judge Arthur Chomley who presided over the County and Supreme Courts of Victoria

Although widely cultivated in plantations *Pinus radiata* is native to three very limited areas in the US: Santa Cruz, Monterey Peninsula, and San Luis Obispo Counties.

The tree is behind the house in a paddock.
