Description

A timber Edwardian house with a complex roof, generally triple-fronted. The left bay steps forward as a verandah, which returns at left under the roof. This has a bold latticed catenary-curved valance on turned posts. At front left is a canted bay window penetrating the verandah and an unusual lantern, with eaves consoles. Its central double-hung window extends with a spandrel panel to floor as an access. At the right angle is a rectangular bay window on the splay. The upper gable jetties forward clad with ripple-iron. Chimneys are dark brown brick with a panelled frieze over corbelled bands.
