STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

A characteristic early Edwardian (c1905) remodeling of a Victorian timber house built between 1879 and 1884. It has architectural significance locally as a representative early Edwardian domestic example and historical significance in embodying life in Newtown in both the early 1880s and early twentieth century as well as changing needs of subsequent owners.

INTACTNESS: Very good. The verandah floor has been replaced with a concrete slab and the flyscreens door and fence are recent.

CONDITIONS & THREATS: Very good.

DESCRIPTION:

A double-fronted timber apparently Edwardian cottage with a hipped roof, the left bay set forward a a gable. This has a sheet metal curlicue finial the upper section is timbered pressed roughcast pattern, jettying. It has a canted bay window with expressed rafters. The hipped verandah is in the angle. It has a wavy palisade valance over a rail, with lyre motif fretwork panels.
