The Tallangatta Peace Garden was created by the Tallangatta Horticultural Society and dedicated on Remembrance Day (11 November) 2004. It is a memorial to all the conflicts that Australia has been involved in

and the name of each conflict is inscribed on a brick paver. The central paving work says 'Peace' and is surrounded by a garden. At the top of the garden there is a large Lone Pine tree.
