Their height and girth make them prime specimens of the species within a suburban/residential environment. Their close planting on the east wall of the residence compliments the height of the tower and their tall columnar stature accentuates the curves of Arthur Pretty's 1940 *Moderne* inspired architecture These specimens are not only notable as prime

example of the species but also contribute a formal element to this aboretum style garden.
