A timber bungalow with a hipped roof and projecting gabled bay to the right of the facade, which has a bay window with four double-hung sash windows. A flat-roofed verandah runs the length of the facade to meet the projecting bay. The verandah is supported by brick piers which rest upon a polychrome brick balustrade. The property retains its original polychrome brick fence, the motif of which matches that of the balustrade.
