A timber bungalow with a hipped roof and projecting gable bay to the left of the facade. A large circular porch is located at the centre of the facade and has a flat roof line which is supported by Ionic columns on a polychrome brick balustrade. There are one-over-two sash windows with horizontal glazing bars, indicating its later date. The property retains its original polychrome brick fence, which mimics the motif of the balustrade.
