Partly intact, verandah (shown on 1962 drainage plan) removed. Weatherboard, transverse gable roof clad in corrugated metal sheeting, brick chimney (now painted). Timber sash windows (possibly replaced) with later shutters, panelled timber door with leadlight highlight.
