An elevated substantial timber Californian Bungalow, built in 1915, in a garden with several mature trees and period garden remnants. It is historically significant for its association with James Bell McAlpin, a leader in local government in both Lilydale and Ringwood. It is also significant as a representative embodiment of comfortable family life in a rural community, beyond the suburbs of Melbourne, in the inter-war period. It is architecturally significant as representative of this domestic style locally.
