## Physical Description 1

Largely intact, symmetrical facade with beaded weatherboards, hipped roof clad in corrugated metal sheeting, bi-chrome brick chimneys (capping missing to north), timber brackets and panels to eaves. Hipped verandah with cast iron frieze, gabled portico, capitals to rear posts and later concrete deck. Timber sash windows, 4 panelled timber door with highlight & sidelights.
