Largely intact, Victorian/ transitional, symmetrical facade, weatherboard (beaded to front), hipped roof clad in corrugated metal sheeting, brick chimneys (altered), cornice with brackets and arched motif (also to timber verandah frieze), bullnose verandah, original tripartite timber sash windows with brackets beneath, original 4 panelled timber door with highlight & sidelights.
