Physical Description 1

Mostly intact, symmetrical facade with beaded weatherboards, hipped roof clad in corrugated metal sheeting, brick chimney (1 retains terra cotta pots), plain timber brackets to eaves. Altered verandah with convex roof, with chamfered timber beams (with dogtooth moulding) & posts (probably had a cast iron frieze; 1926 aerial - SLV, C Pratt, H91.160/806). 4 panelled timber door with highlight and sidelights, timber sash windows with Queen Anne sill.
