Largely intact, symmetrical bi-chrome brick facade, hipped roof clad in slate, brick chimneys. Concave verandah with new tiled deck, plain columns with capitals & timber framed cast iron frieze. Segmental arched timber sash windows, 4 panelled timber door with leadlight highlight.
