Physical Description 1

Partly intact with alterations to front, possibly had been a pair with no.19. Brick with basalt plinth (now painted), hipped roof clad in slate, brick chimney (now partly rendered), later skillion verandah (original verandah was same height & profile as no. 19), partly filled in. Segmental arched timber sash window, 4 panelled door with leadlight highlight.
